Foliage & Flowering Features: The multi-coloured blooms of the Calibrachoa are the most striking feature of the plant, flowering for most of the year except in the cooler months. The bushy green foliage provides a lush backdrop for the brightly-hued flowers.

Origin: South America

Uses: Lasting Bouquet looks fantastic both in the garden and indoors. Place in the middle of the table of an outdoor setting, or bring a pot inside for some indoor colour. Make sure you bring the plant back outside after a week or so however - Calibrachoa love sunlight.

Maintenance: Easy care. Fertilise with a liquid fertiliser.
